The former Prime Minister Kevin Rudd visits the Northern Territory Stolen Generations Casuarina offices

On Tuesday 13th of January, the former Prime Minister the Honourable Kevin Rudd visited the office of the Northern Territory Stolen Generations, Casuarina.

The NTSGAC had been actively involved with the National Apology Foundation and as a result, Mr Rudd had requested a visit to introduce himself to staff and the Directors of the board.

Mr Rudd emphasised the importance of the work that the Stolen Generations organisation is doing through the Link-Up program, family tracing and family re-unions. Helping Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people reunite with family members who had been separated by past government policies, is very important work.

Mr Rudd talked about the National Apology Foundation, which he had established since leaving parliament. The current levels of Indigenous disadvantage and measures taken to Close the Gap targets.

The former Prime Minister also spoke about Australia's Stolen Generations and the 2008 Apology.

The NT Stolen Generations invited Mr Rudd to become an Ambassador or friend of the NT Stolen Generations. Mr Rudd accepted the offer and was extremely excited about the opportunity to support us.

The NT Stolen Generations will be approaching other prominent Australians to become Ambassadors or friends of the NT Stolen Generations.
