Board of Directors

Northern Territory Stolen Generations Aboriginal Corporation Board of Directors is drawn from its membership. Any Stolen Generations Resident of the Yilli Rreung Region is eligible to apply to be a Board Director. The Board has nine members who are elected for three-year terms. These positions are that of Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and seven Directors.

Senior Staff

The day to day operations of Northern Territory Stolen Generations Aboriginal Corporation are vested in the Chief Executive Officer, who is appointed by the Board of Directors, and reports on the day to day operations of the Link-Up delivery at each Board meeting. The Chief Executive Officer is also responsible for the implementation of the Organisation's strategic directions and future planning and growth.

Vision Statement

The Northern Territory Stolen Generations and their families live happy, healthy productive lives while still retaining their unique and important identity within the social fabric, as original Australians.

Focus of the Organisation

The focus of the organization is to address the political and social disadvantage of our members. The primary issues remain constant, though over time the pathways have changed. The issues of Healing, Truth and Justice are the foundations in building a strong and healthy future for those who were removed, and their descendants; many of whom continue to experience intergenerational trauma whilst maintaining their identity as Stolen Generations people.

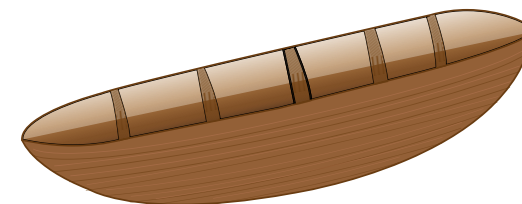
